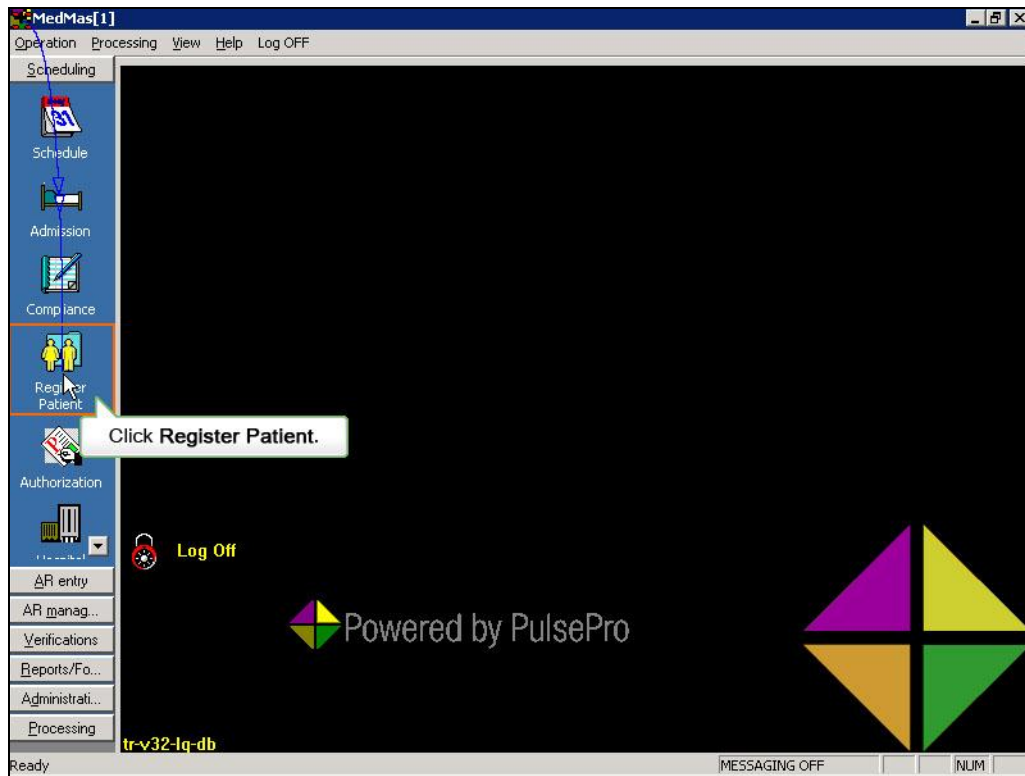


**ABOUT WORKING WITH THE PHARMACIES TABLE**

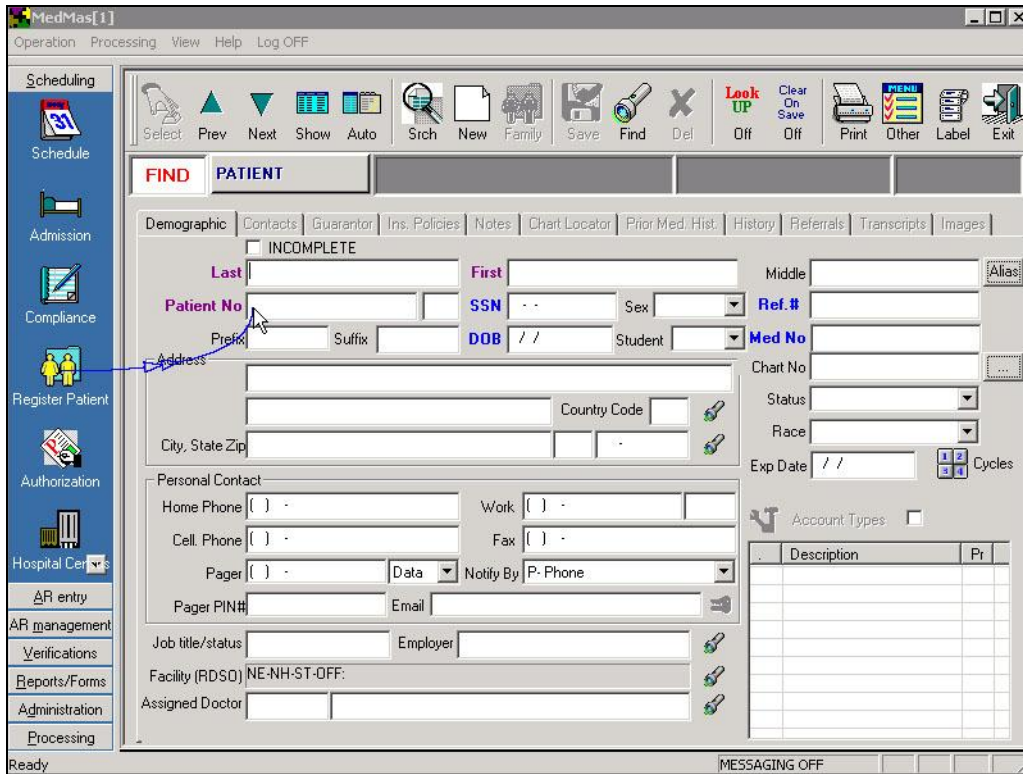
The Pharmacies table is used to configure the **Pharmacies** which provide services to the patients in your practice.

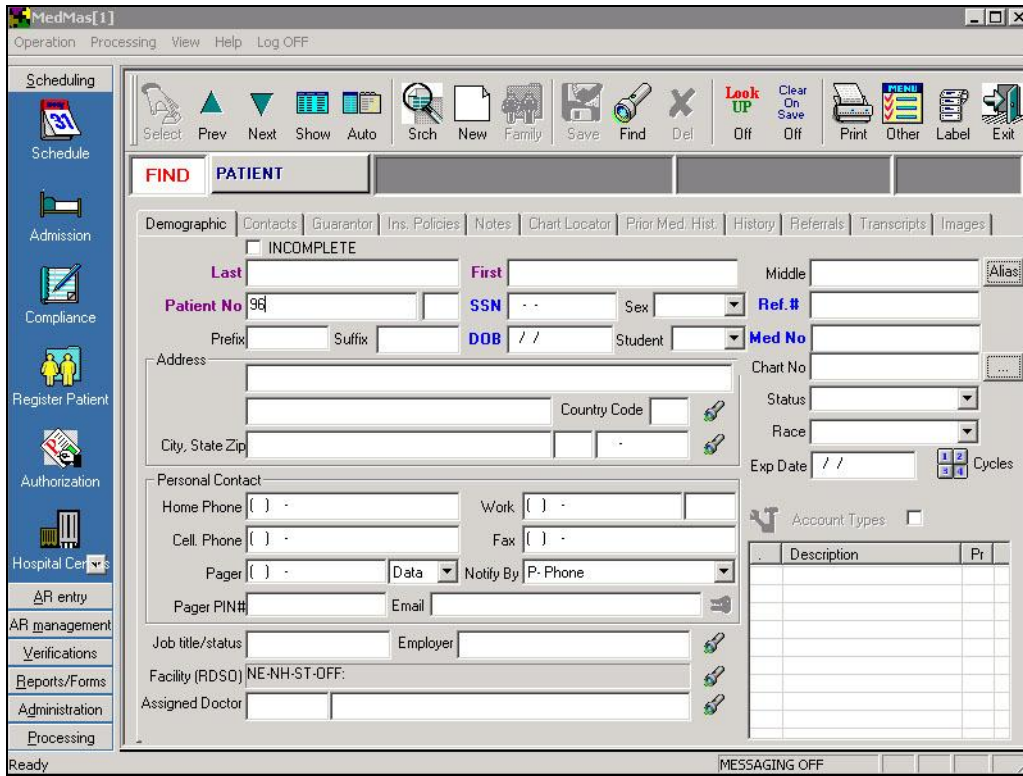

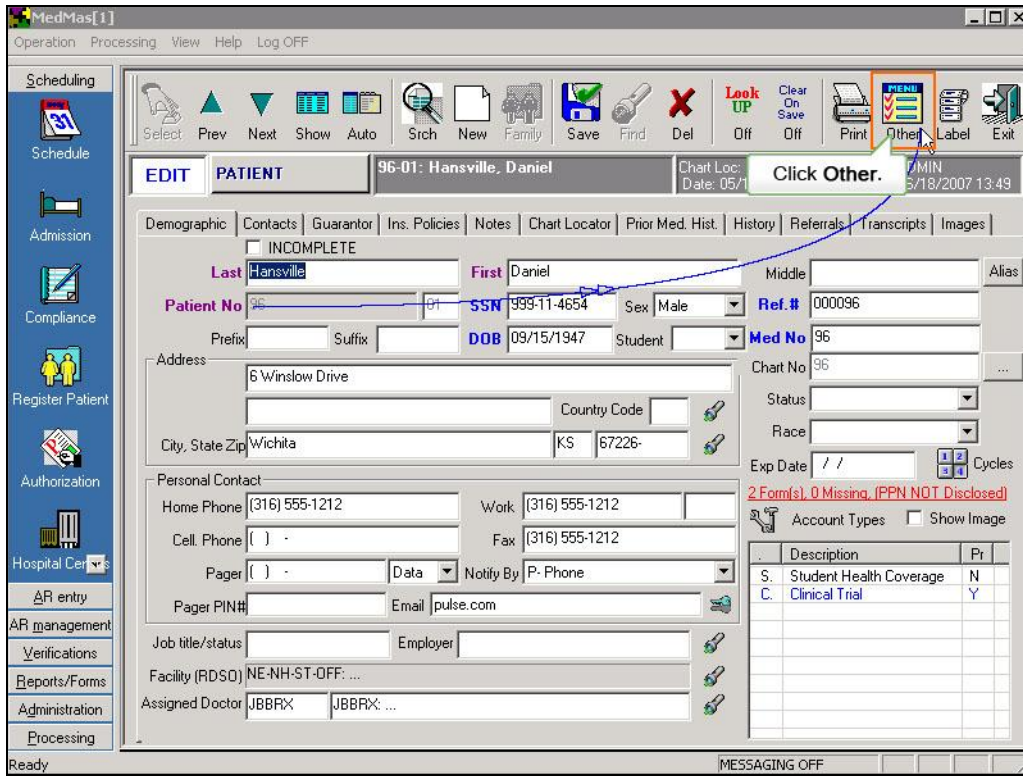
In the Scheduling Group, click the Register Patient icon.



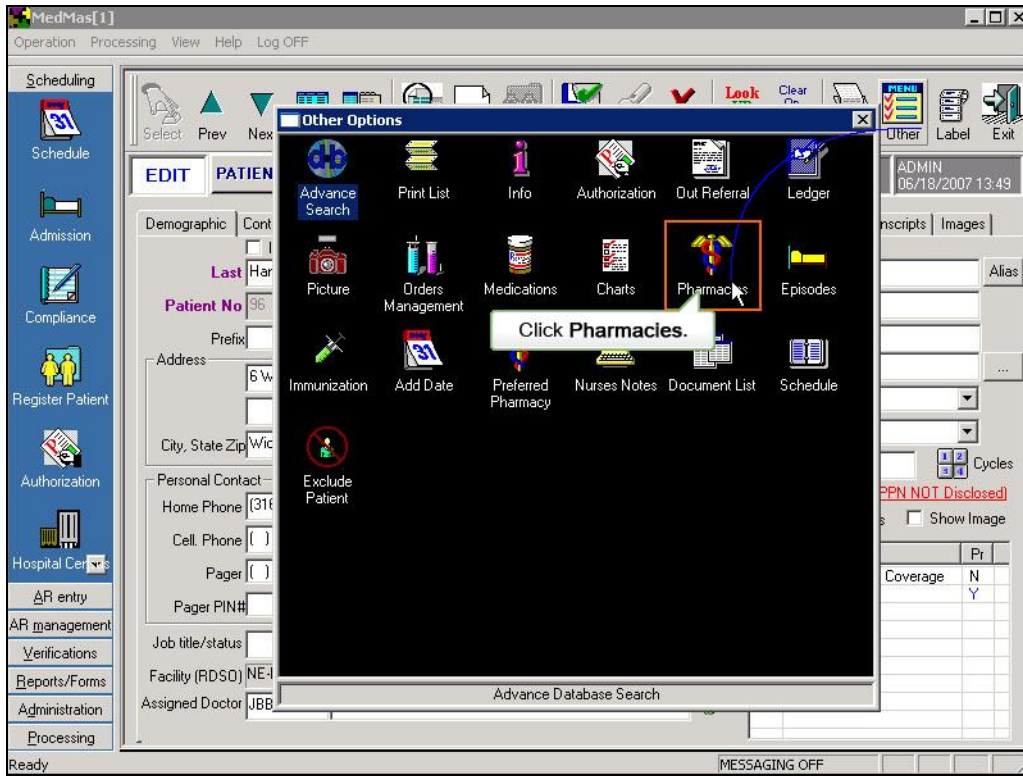
The Patient Registration window opens. Access any patient's record in the normal manner. This patient will only be used to provide access the pharmacy table in this lesson.



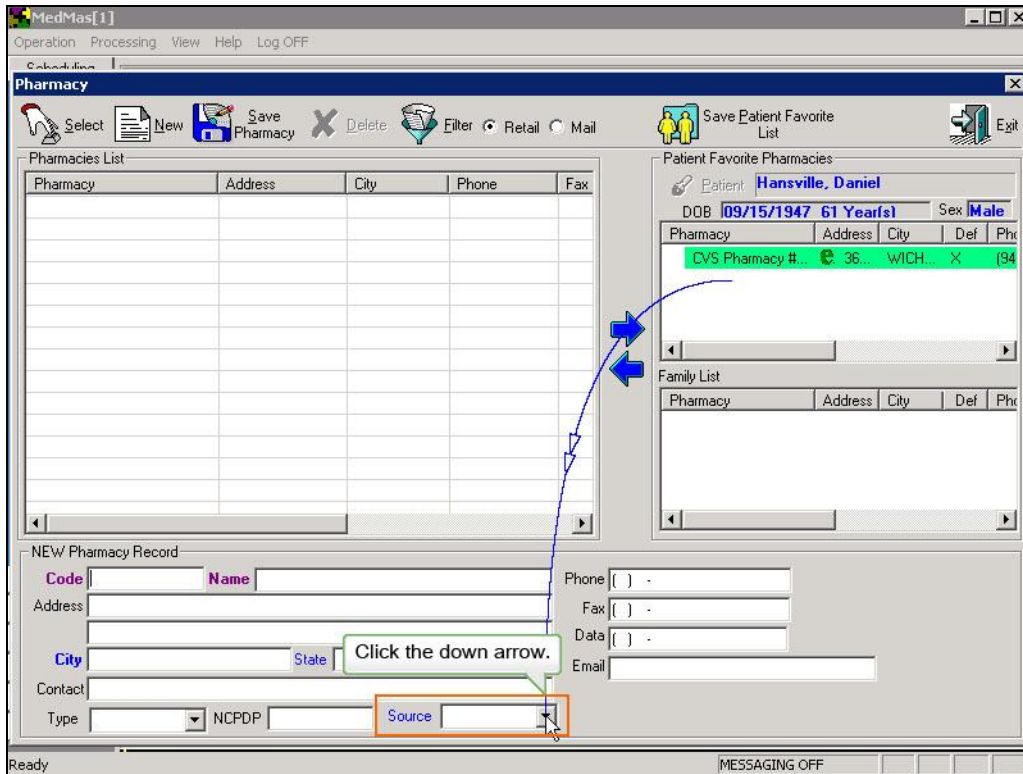
## Typing Animation



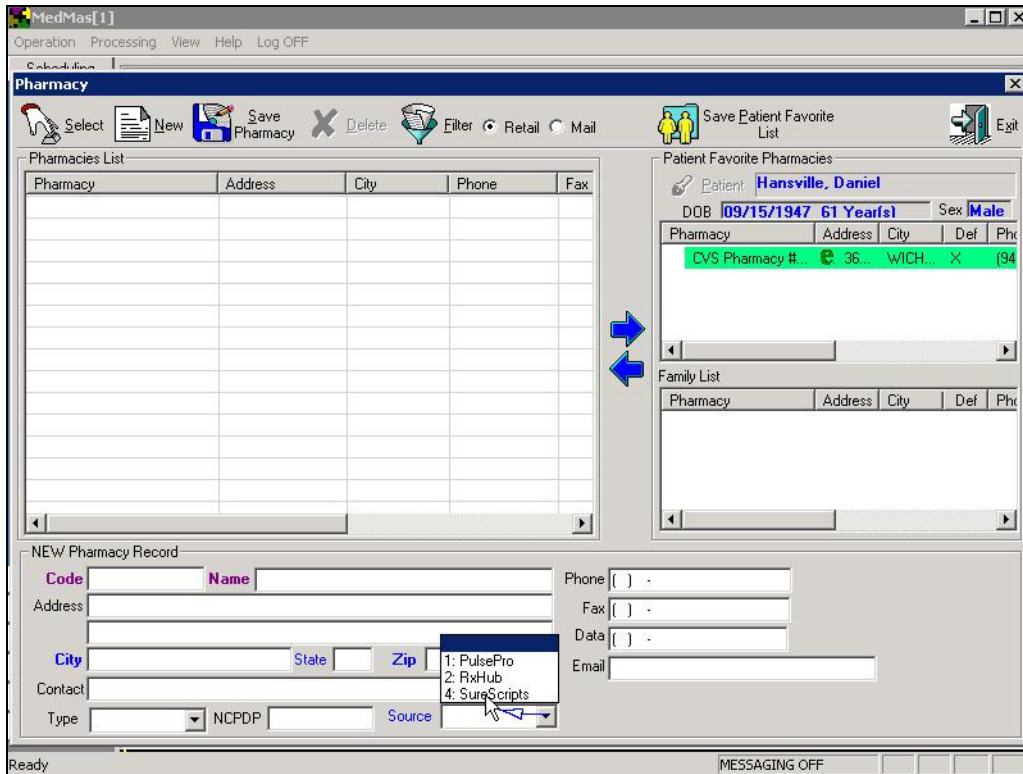
With a patient's record selected, click the Other button on the toolbar.



The Other Options window opens. Locate and click the Pharmacies icon.

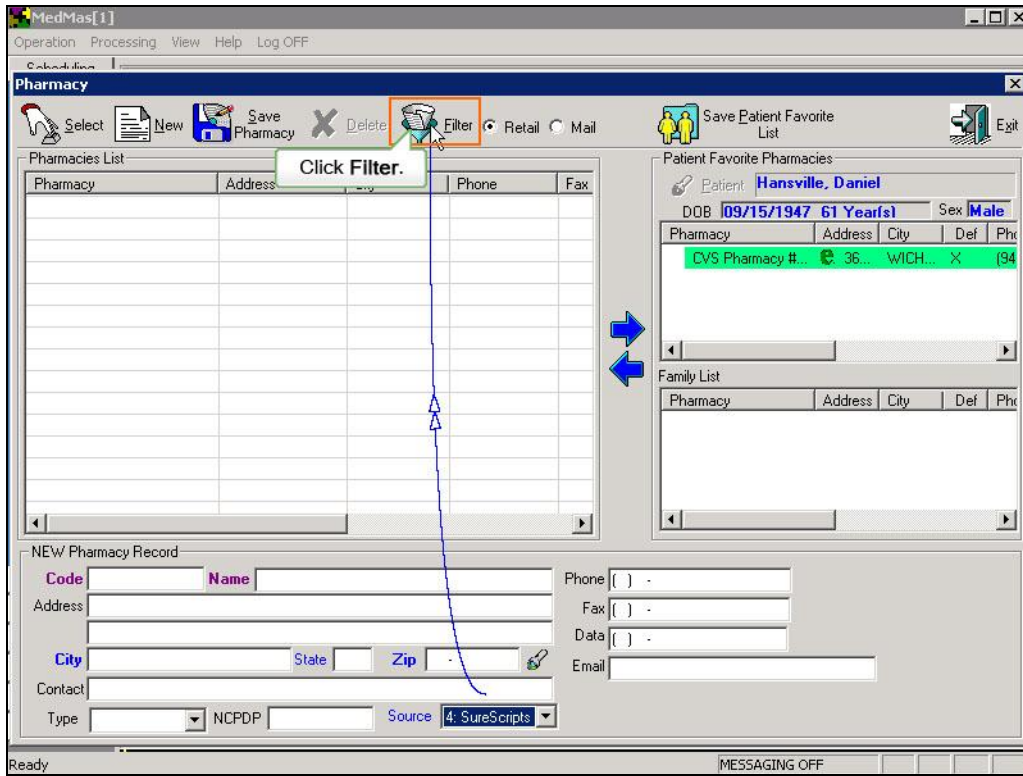


The Pharmacy window opens consisting of a toolbar, pharmacies list, and patient favorite pharmacies. Click the down arrow on the Source field.

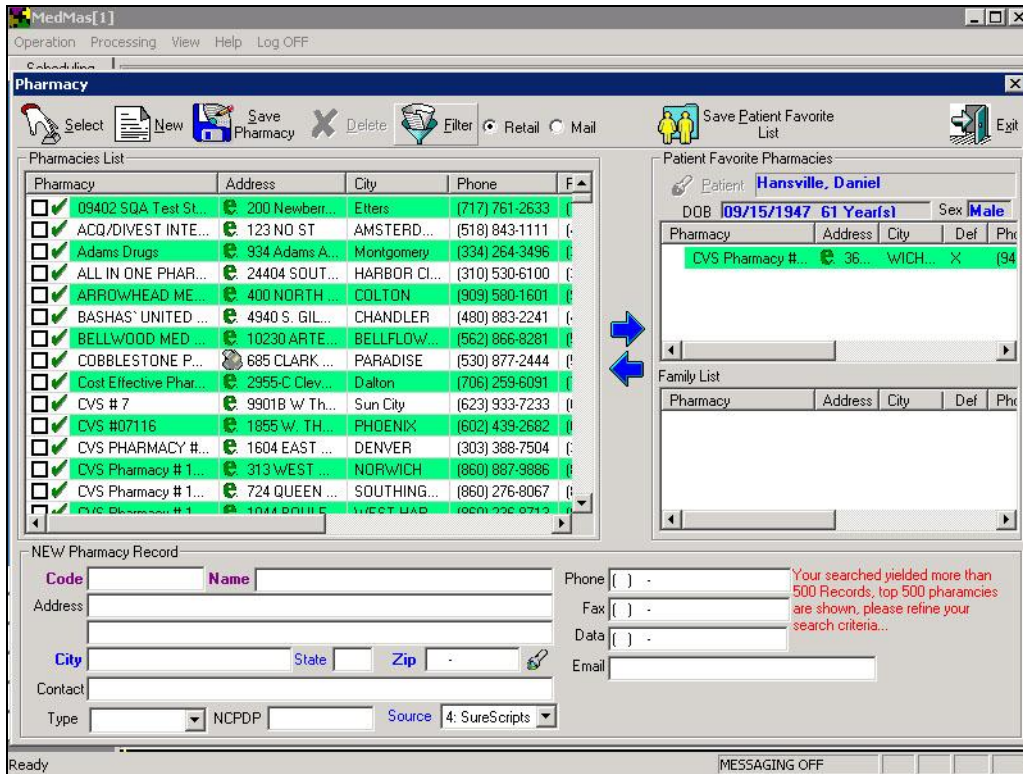


Select from the lists available. PulsePro are those pharmacies that have been manually entered by you. RxHub are the downloaded Mail order pharmacies, and SureScripts are the downloaded retail eSIG pharmacies. Click SureScripts.

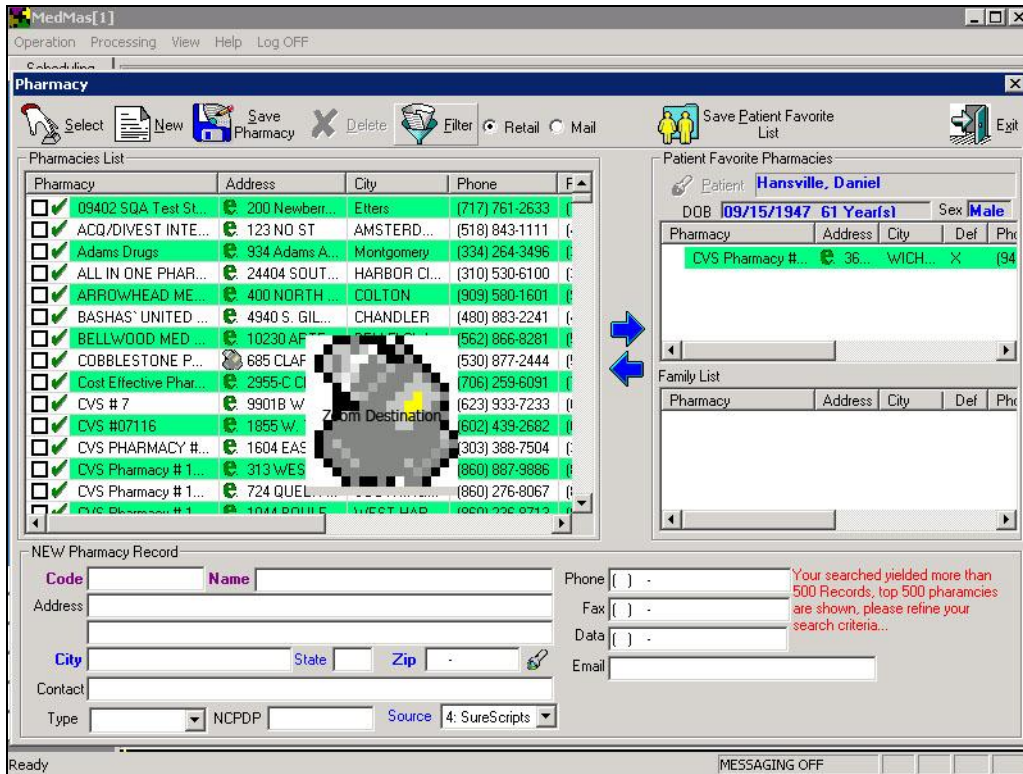




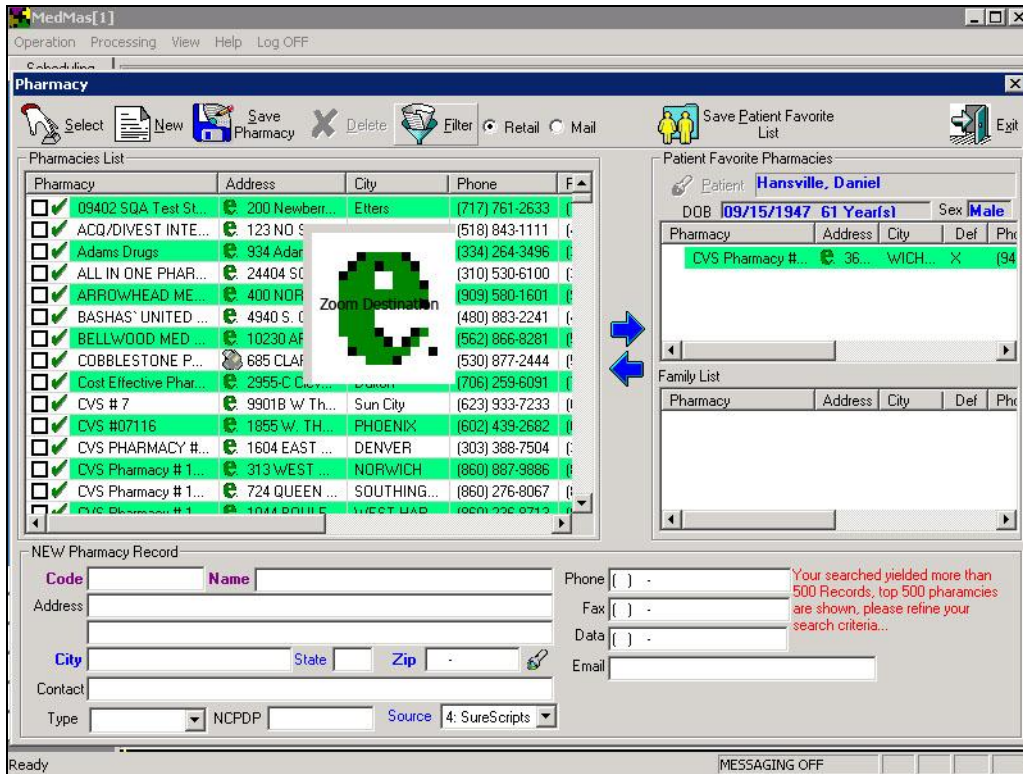
Click the Filter button on the toolbar.



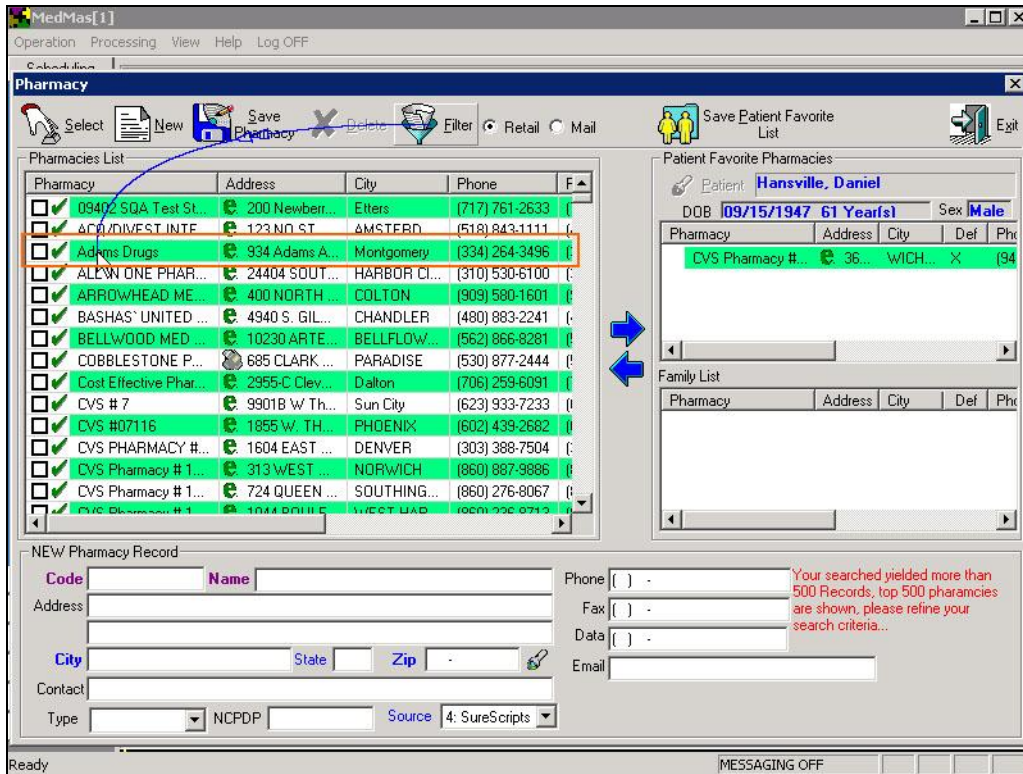
The Pharmacies List refreshes listing the nationwide pharmacies in the SureScripts network and typically contains every pharmacy in your area. This list is updated nightly by the eRX service.



Pharmacies listed with a Fax icon indicate these pharmacies are not currently enabled to receive eSIGs. Transmitting an eSIG to these pharmacies will result in a 14 cent fax charge from SureScripts. Fortunately, these records are easily identified when prescribing medications and you can fax these prescriptions using your current Pulse Fax Server or print the prescriptions manually to avoid this charge.

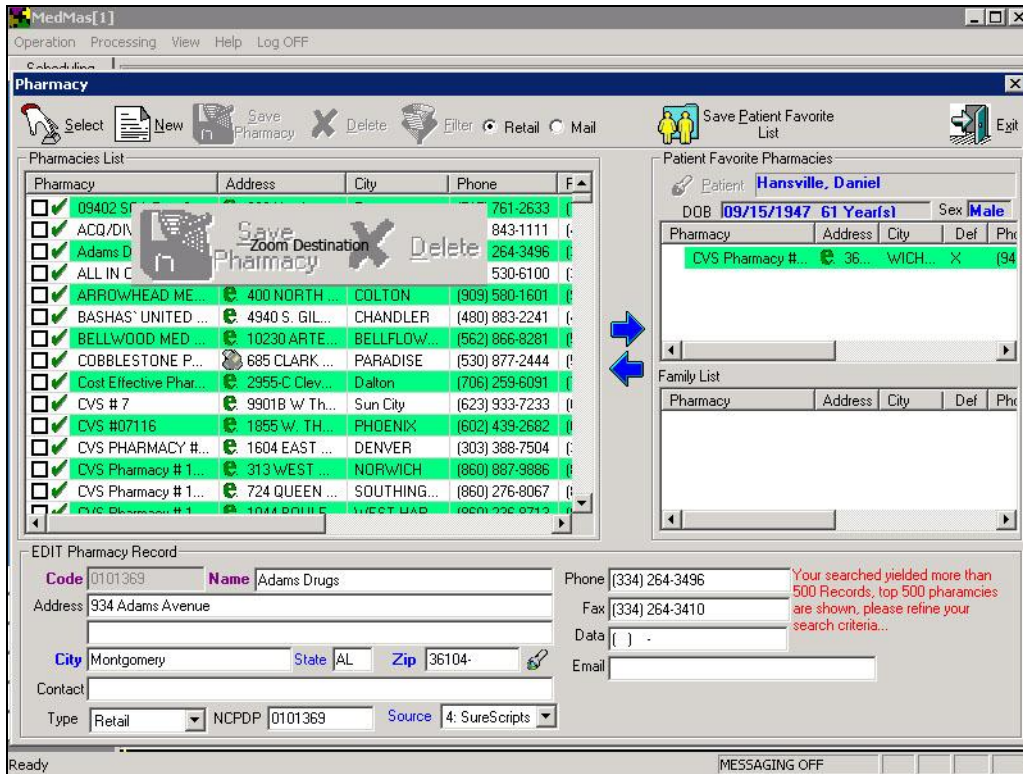


Pharmacies listed with a Green E icon indicate that these pharmacies participate with eSIGs.

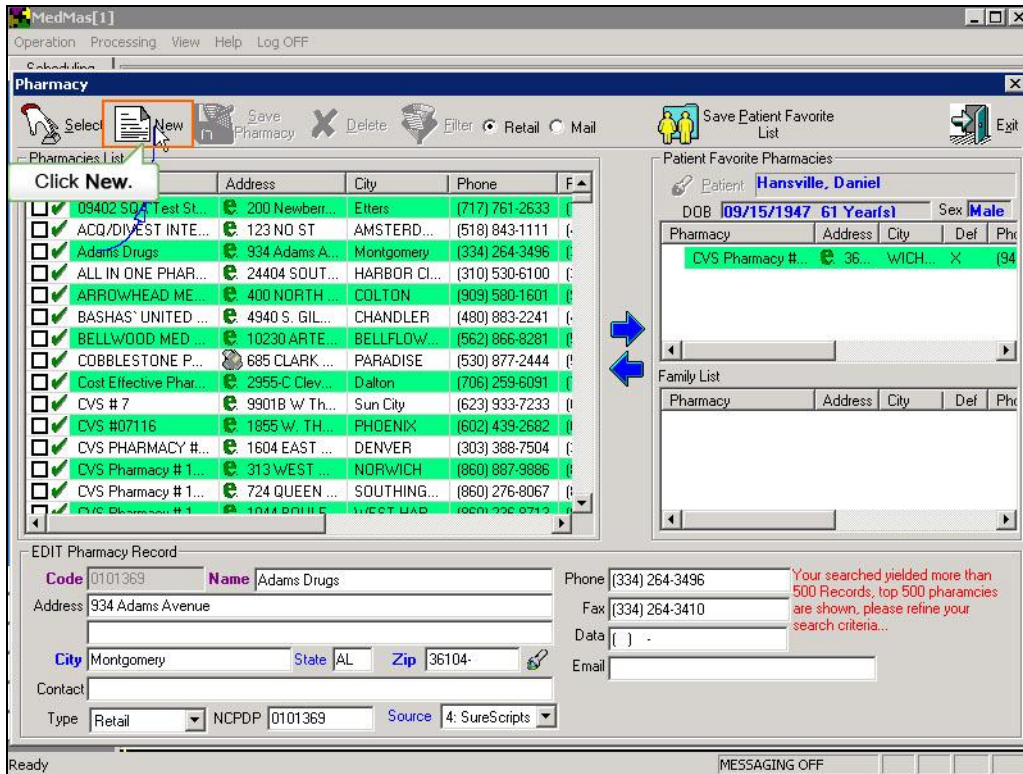


Click on a pharmacy in the list.

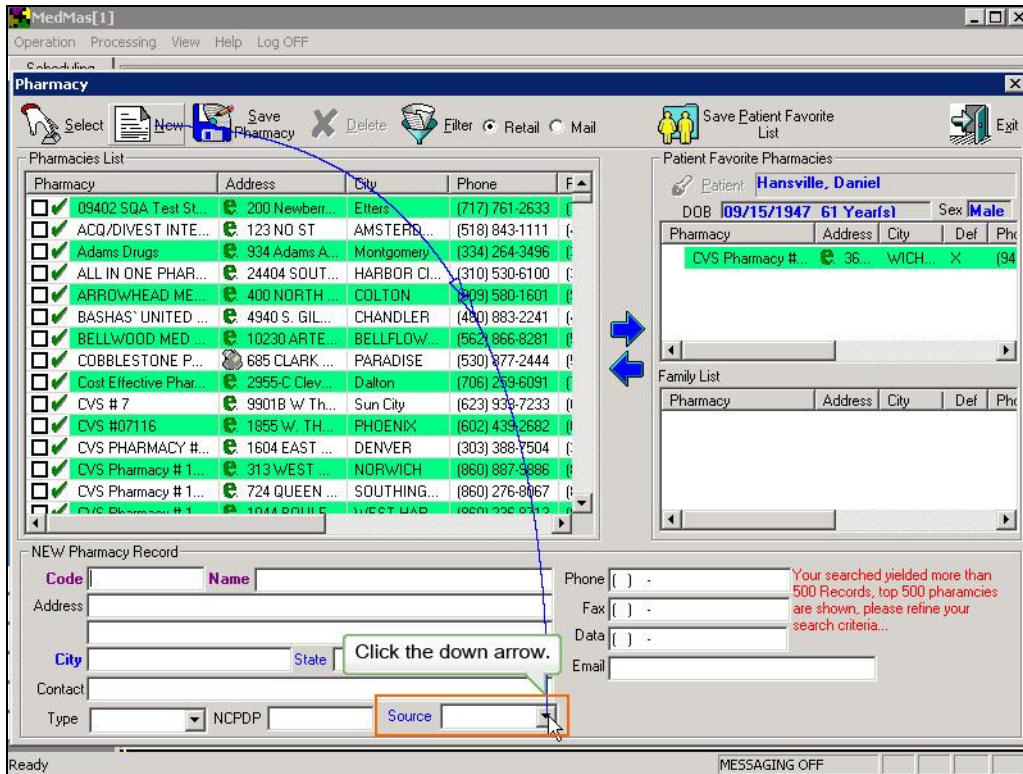




The pharmacy record details display at the bottom and note you cannot save changes or delete these SureScripts records.

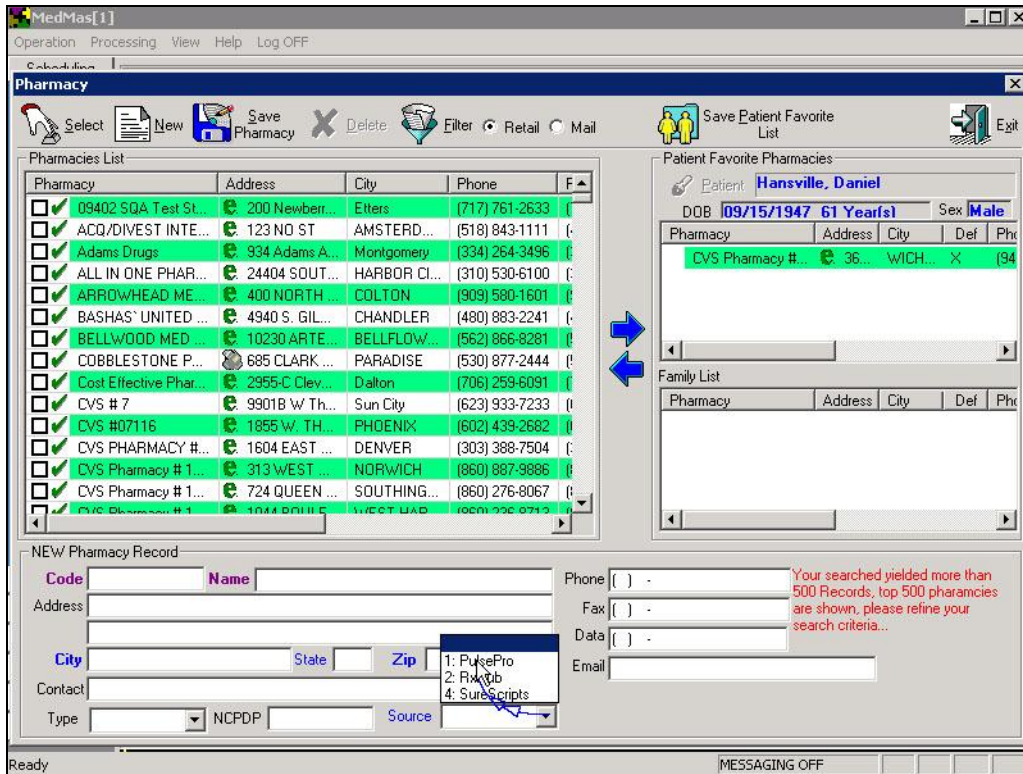


If you need to add a new pharmacy that is not included in the SureScripts list, click the new button on the toolbar.

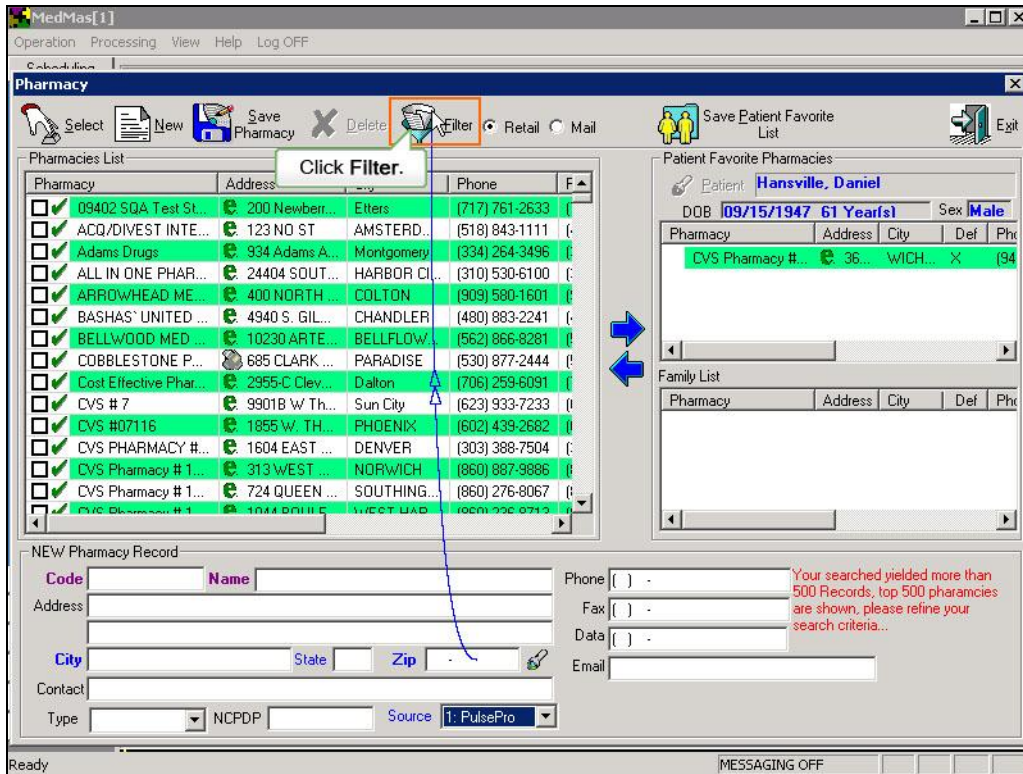


Click the down arrow on the source field.

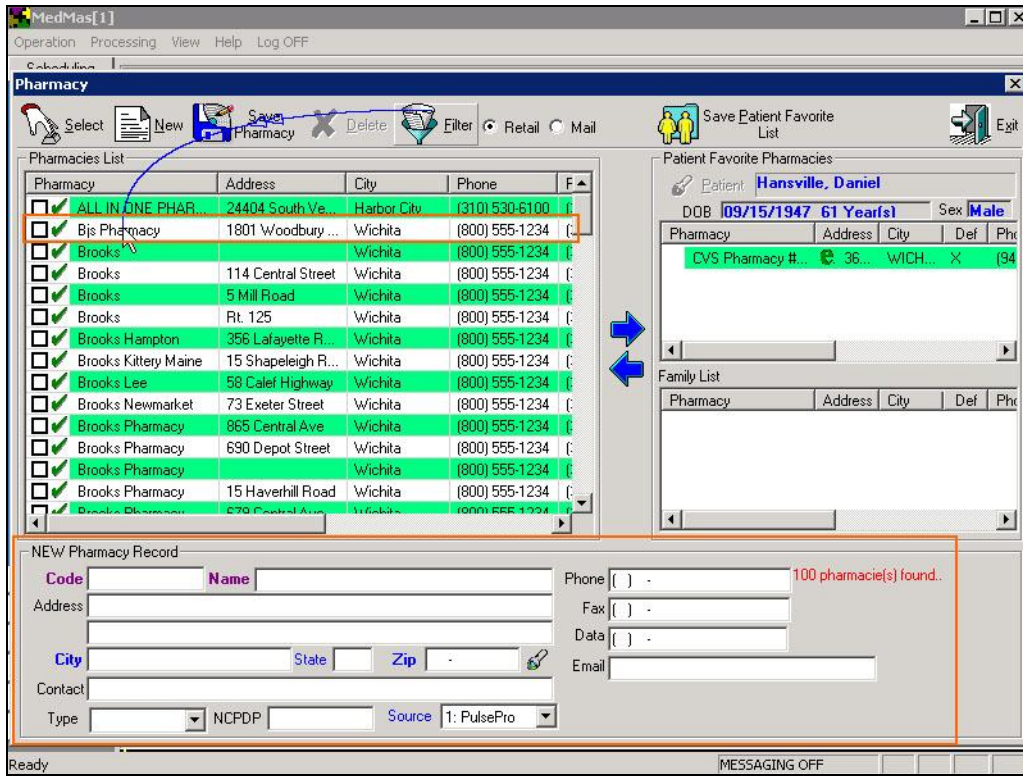




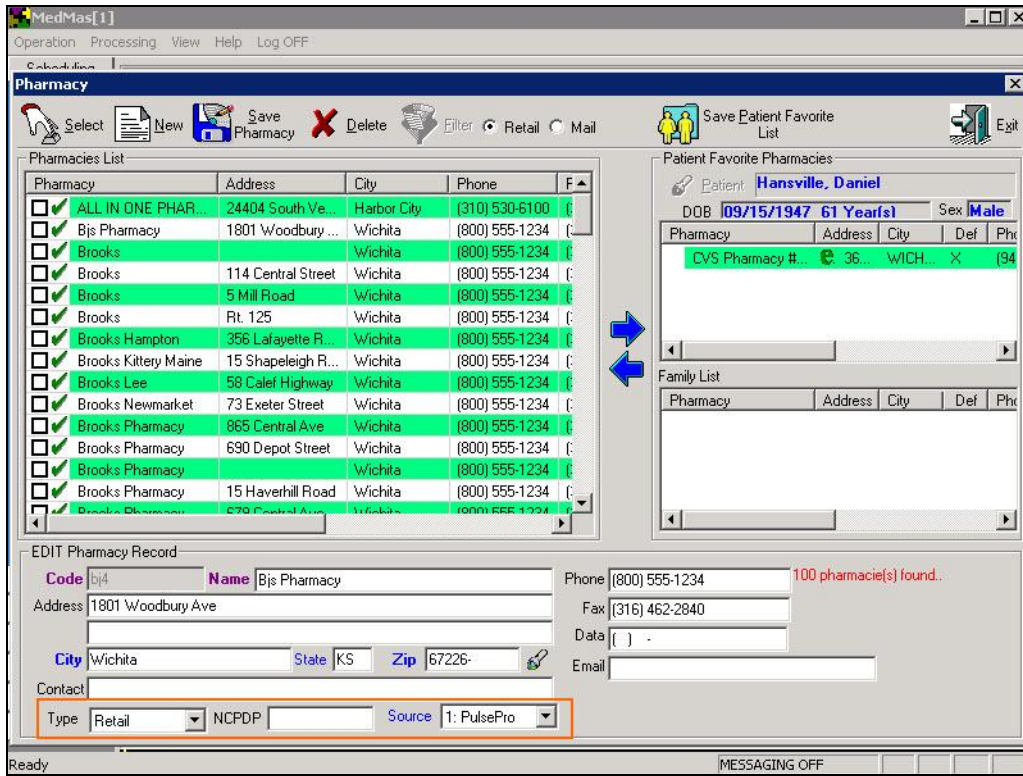
Click PulsePro.



Click the Filter button on the toolbar.



The pharmacies list refreshes with the manually entered PulsePro pharmacies. You may now add a new pharmacy record in the bottom area or click on an item in the list to edit the details.



The details display for the manually entered pharmacy with the type of Retail, No NCPDP, and a Source of PulsePro.

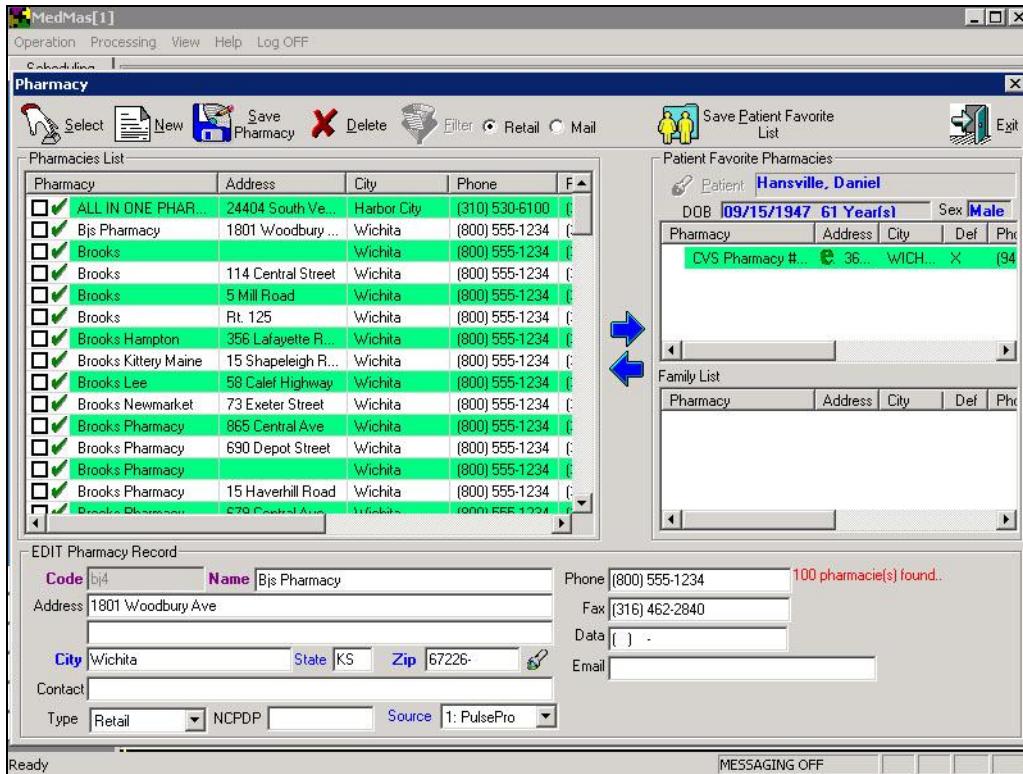
## MANUALLY ENTERED PHARMACIES

If the NCPDP ID of the pharmacy is saved to a *PulsePro Source* pharmacy, the *eRX* module will recognize if that pharmacy is already in the *eRX* network based off this ID# and the module will utilize the record from the *eRX* Network pharmacy to transmit the prescription instead of the PulsePro source pharmacy.

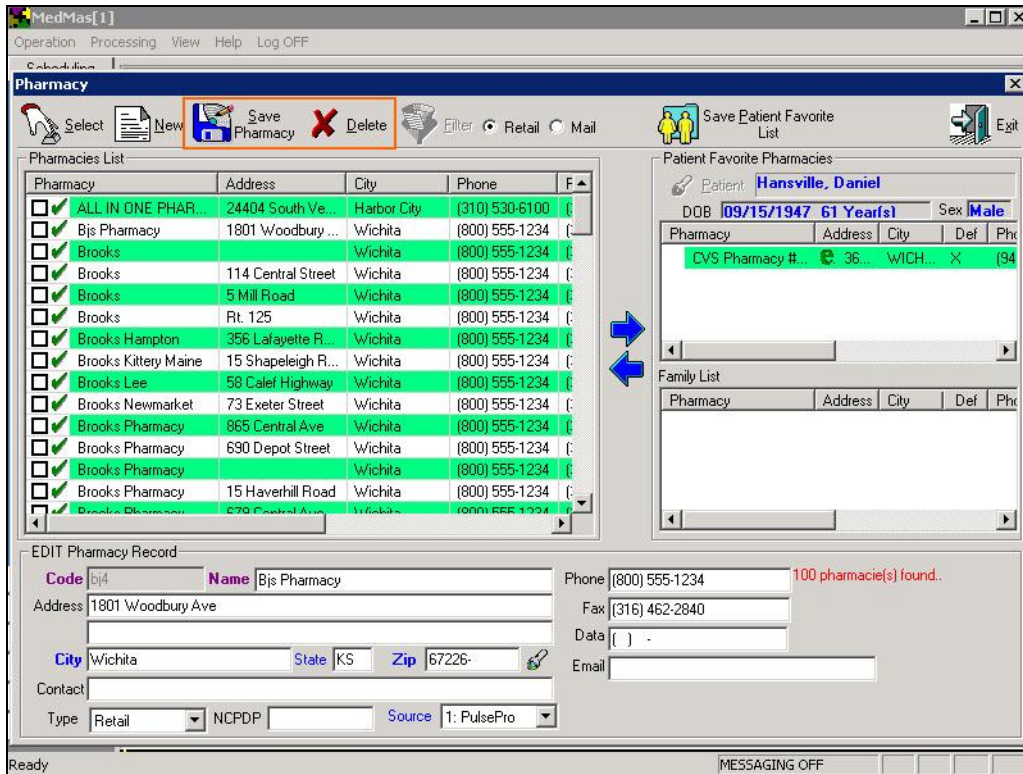
Click Box

If the NCPDP ID of the pharmacy is saved to a PulsePro Source pharmacy, the eRX module will recognize if that pharmacy is already in the eRX network based off this ID# and the module will utilize the record from the eRX Network pharmacy to transmit the prescription instead of the PulsePro source pharmacy. Click anywhere to continue.

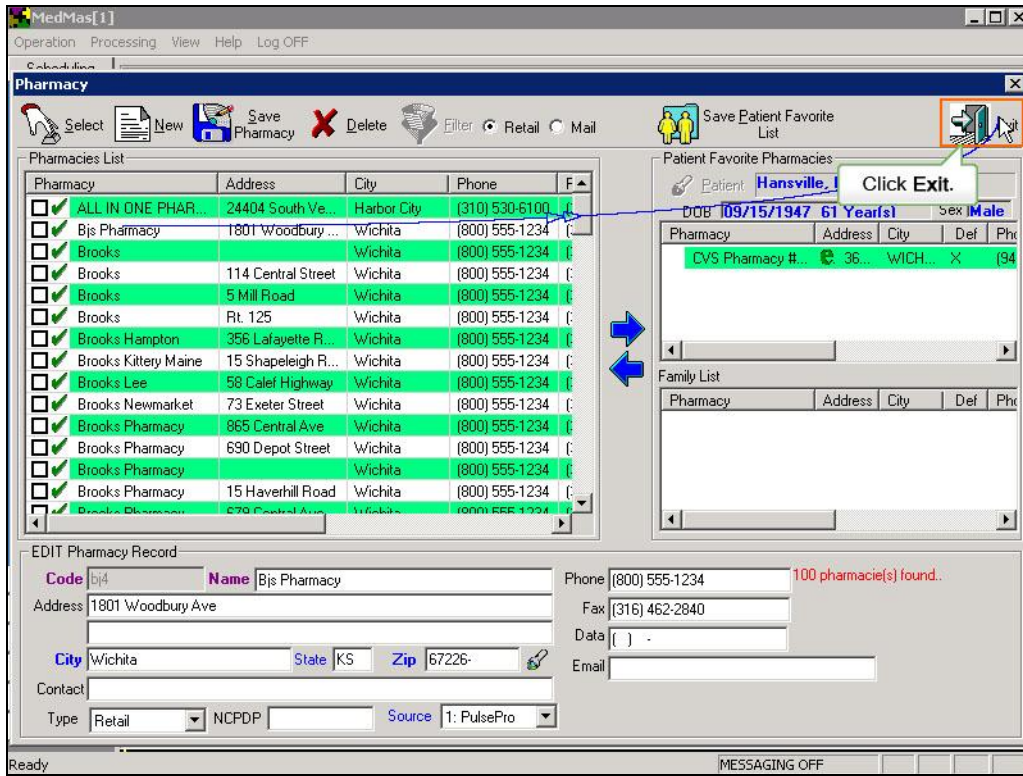


Typically, the only reason to have a manually entered pharmacy is if the pharmacy is not included in the SureScripts network or you want to utilize a different fax number.



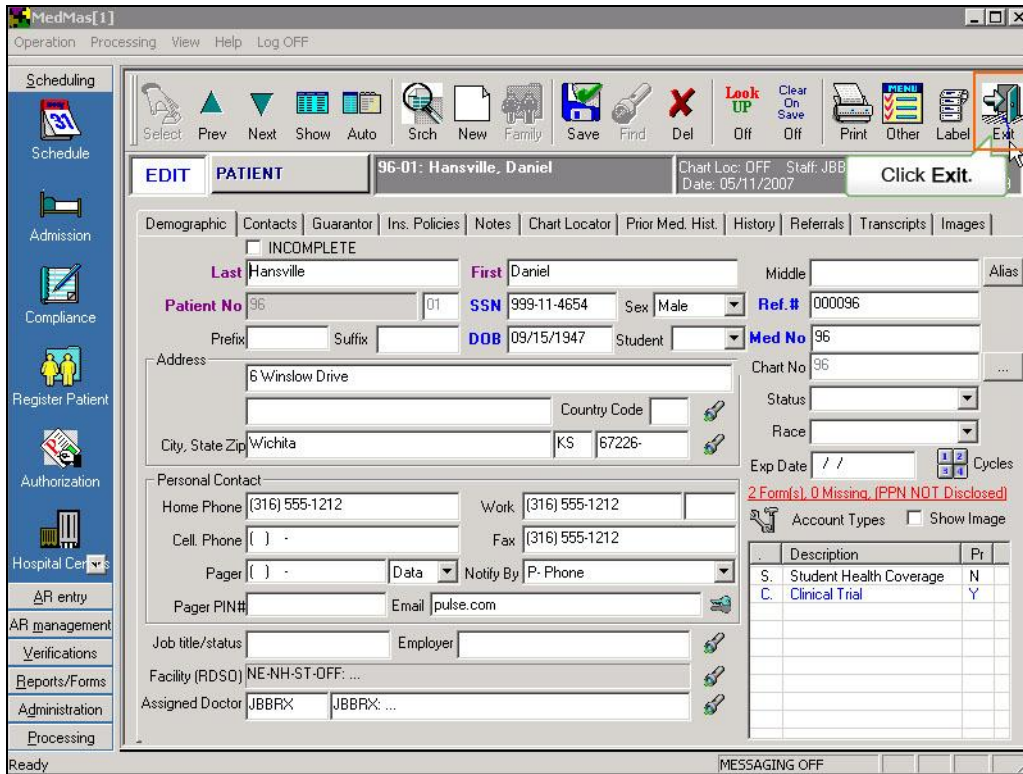


You may delete this pharmacy by clicking the Delete button on the toolbar or click the Save Pharmacy button on the toolbar to save this record.



When complete, click the exit button on the toolbar.
